

David and Brian Marshall Memorial Scholarship

Created in memory of David and Brian Marshall, this scholarship recognizes a currently-enrolled Counselor Education entry-level or doctoral student for his or her consistent and dedicated all-round service to the Department of Counselor Education community and the counseling profession during the current academic year.

Award Criteria

The award criteria reflect David and Brian's spirit of commitment and dedication to the Department community, its ongoing improvement, their pursuit of academic and professional excellence, their dedication to Department activities independent of and in partnership with student organizations (e.g., Beta Chapter Chi Sigma Iota and Counselors for Social Justice), their involvement in leadership positions within the Department, and their generosity of spirit in responding when help was needed. Criteria include:

1. Currently enrolled graduate student in the Department of Counselor Education;
2. Demonstrated academic excellence as evidenced by a minimum overall graduate GPA of 3.75);
3. Demonstrated consistent involvement in leadership roles within the Department as evidenced by involvement in at least one of the following:
 - a. Voluntary assistance in teaching undergraduate or graduate courses,
 - b. Leadership in Beta Chapter Chi Sigma Iota and/or Counselors for Social Justice, or
 - c. Voluntary involvement in Department events (e.g., admissions interviews, orientation, other social events, community-building events, student organization sponsored events, etc.);
4. Leadership within the academic year in professional development activities, as evidenced by at least one of the following:
 - a. Conference presentation, workshop, or poster,
 - b. Manuscript development and submission,
 - c. External funding, or
 - d. Community-based outreach or workshop;
5. Demonstrated commitment to the Department community's improvement as evidenced by peer and faculty support.

Nomination Instructions

1. Nominations may be made by a student peer or by a faculty member. Self-nominations will not be considered. Nomination packets should be submitted to Candy or Patty in the Counselor Education office – 1215 Norman Hall **no later than 5:00pm on Monday, April 14th**. Nomination packets shall include:
 - a. Nomination Letter indicating the rationale for the nominee being considered, addressing nominee's demonstration of qualities outlined in criteria;
 - b. Current resume or curriculum vita; and
 - c. One additional letter of support from either faculty member or student peer, depending on whether a student or faculty member made the nomination.
2. Nominations will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee. The recipient will be announced at the Spring 2008 Counselor Education Graduation Ceremony. All nominees are asked to attend the Counselor Education Graduation Ceremony.
