The Department of Educational Administration and Policy is pleased to offer their first international study tour. The United Kingdom and Ireland are the countries selected for this first tour.

Three (3) graduate credits will be included with the program fee. (EDH 6947 Student Personnel in Higher Education Practicum*). The course is being offered to University of Florida graduate students in the Student Personnel in Higher Education program as well as other graduate students outside the department and university.

Students will have an opportunity to meet with student services staff and student leaders at 6 universities. Students will also have the opportunity to explore London, Hertfordshire, Huddersfield and Manchester (England), and Galway & Dublin (Ireland).

Program Goals

- Provide an opportunity for students to compare student service delivery systems.
- Learn about issues on college campuses in other countries.
- Exchange ideas with international hosts.
- Learn about the customs, culture, economic way of life, government and literature of people from England and Ireland.
- Develop international contacts.

Program Expenses

\$2,225 – Fee includes 3 graduate credits, 11 nights of accommodation, 11 breakfasts, 4 lunches, 2 dinners and ground transportation to and from events in the UK and Ireland.

NOT INCLUDED IN FEE – Airfare from the US to England and Ireland to US. Airfare is at the expense of each student and student is responsible to book their flight.
